The city of Paris joins the European Route "Destination Napoleon"

By deliberation of March 29, 2017, the Council of Paris has just voted its membership of the European Federation of Napoleonic Cities and thus takes place in the European Cultural Route Destination Napoleon certified by the Council of Europe.

Paris becomes the first capital city to join the Federation which already brings together sixty cities in thirteen European countries from Portugal to Russia, from Italy to Poland.

The cities of Berlin, Vienna, Moscow, Luxemburg and others will be solicited to create within the Federation a group of European capitals crossed by Napoleonic history.

They will give a new dimension to Destination Napoleon: a development of a cultural and tourist offer around the figure and deeds of Napoleon in the priority direction of guests from Asia and America.
